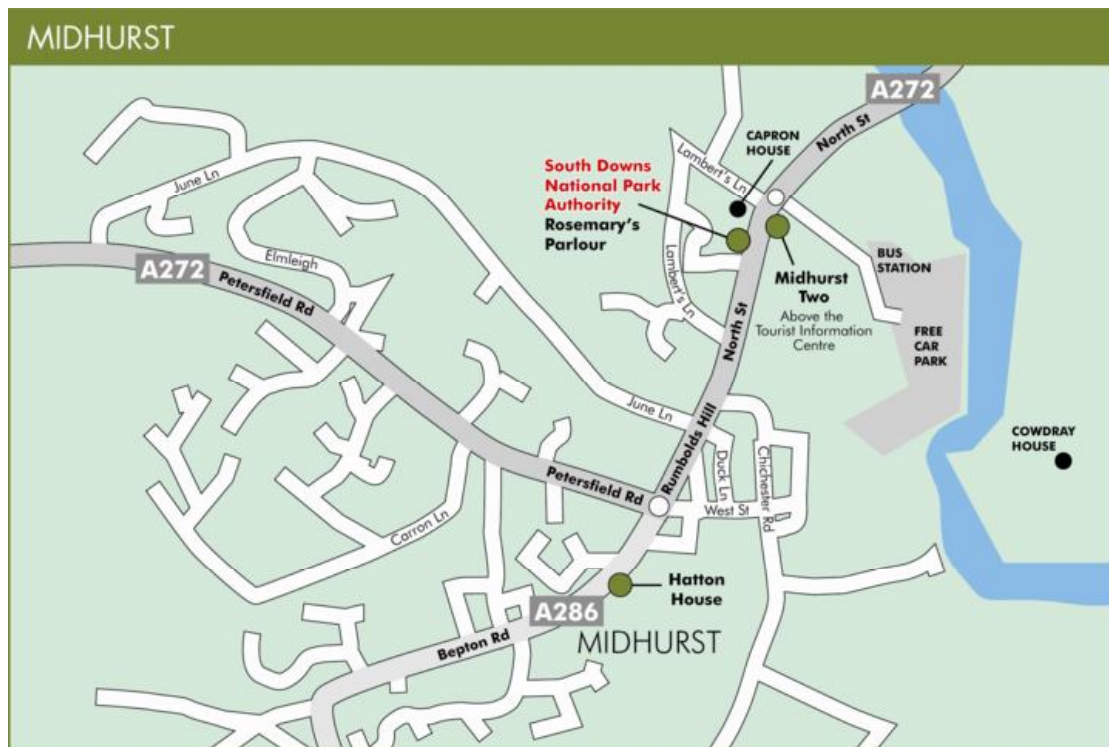

On foot

Our main office is at Hatton House which can be found on the main road to Chichester from Midhurst known as Bepton Road. Opposite Lavant Workwear, you will see two buildings with an entrance to a small car park behind. Hatton House is the right hand building. Please knock on the door labelled South Downs National Park Authority.

N.B. If you do travel by car, please park at either the Grange Street or North Street public car parks and walk to the offices. We have disabled parking available at Hatton House, but due to the limited availability please call in advance to book a space.



Further details of how to get to Midhurst by train, bus and car can be found overleaf.

By train

There is no train station at Midhurst. The nearest train station is Haslemere with nearby train stations also at Petersfield and Chichester. Trains from London Waterloo to Portsmouth usually stop at Haslemere, which is approx 7 miles from Midhurst.

On arrival at Haslemere, Stagecoach run a bus service (route 70, 71 and 92) which takes about 25 minutes to Midhurst Bus Station. There is a taxi stand at Haslemere Station - a taxi should take less than 20 minutes drive to Midhurst.

By Bus

On arrival at Midhurst Bus station, please follow the 'on foot' directions overleaf.

Bus timetable

Haslemere to Midhurst

From Haslemere Train Station to Midhurst Bus Stand

0723, 0834, then 04 mins past the hour until last bus at 1834

Chichester to Midhurst

From Chichester Bus/Train Station to Midhurst Bus Stand

0653, 0718, 0746, then at 16 and 46 mins past the hour until 1846, then 36 mins past the hour until last bus at 2236.

By car - driving north on the A3

Leave the A3 at the junction signposted A272 Midhurst. Take the slip road which leads to a roundabout. Take the first exit at the roundabout and travel down through the village of Sheet. As you drive up the hill, take the A272 which turns right to Midhurst. Drive along the A272 to Midhurst for approximately 9 miles (driving through the village of Rogate etc). As you enter Midhurst turn left at the mini roundabout (continuation of A272) which takes you onto North Street. You will drive past Tesco's Express on the left and the Angel Hotel on the right. To park, continue along the road, just past the bus station and turn right at the mini-roundabout into the Car Park signposted 'Council Offices Car Park'. Parking in this car park is free for 2 hours, but you are still required to gain a ticket from the machine. Once parked, please follow directions for 'on foot' overleaf.

By car – driving south on the A3

Leave the A3 at junction signed posted A287 (Hindhead crossroads).

Travel along the Hindhead Road towards Haslemere & Midhurst for 2.1miles. Turn right onto Church Road A287. Continue across the traffic lights onto Sturt Road (A287). This turns into Bell Road (A286). Once at the T Junction turn right onto Midhurst Road passing through the village of Fernhurst. Continue along the A286 until you come to a roundabout. Turn right (A272) - you will then enter Midhurst. At the next mini roundabout turn left into the car park signposted 'Council Offices Car Park'. Parking in this car park is free free for 2 hours, but you are still required to gain a ticket from the machine. Once parked, please follow directions for 'on foot' overleaf.
