Standards and Audit Committee – Terms of Reference

Standards

- 1. To oversee the discharge of the Authority's duty to promote and maintain high standards of conduct by Members and Co-opted Members.
- 2. To promote training and advice to Members and Co-opted Members on the Code of Conduct, relevant protocols adopted by the Authority, and related matters to enable high standards of conduct to be maintained.
- 3. To advise the Authority on the revision or replacement of its Code of Conduct for Members and Co-opted Members, and on the review of protocols relevant to ethical standards.
- 4. To advise the Authority on the arrangements to be applied for the investigation and determination of allegations of failure to comply with the Code of Conduct for Members and Co-opted Members, including advice on the involvement of at least one independent person in those arrangements, and to handle and determine such allegations in accordance with the approved procedures.
- 5. To consider and determine an application by a Member or Co-opted Member for the grant of a dispensation under Section 33 Localism Act 2011, relieving the restrictions on participation in, and voting on, a matter in which the Member or Coopted Member has a disclosable pecuniary interest.

Audit

- 6. To provide assurance on the adequacy of internal audit arrangements.
- 7. To ensure the robustness of risk management and internal audit arrangements.
- 8. To consider the adequacy of arrangements for the prevention and detection of fraud and corruption.
- 9. To agree the internal audit plan and annual report, and receive progress and other relevant internal audit reports.
- 10. To agree the District Auditor's Annual Audit and Inspection Plan, and receive the District Auditor's Annual Governance Statement and other relevant reports.
- 11. To review the Authority's Annual Governance Statement.
- 12. To approve the Statement of Accounts in accordance with the Accounts and Audit (England) Regulations 2011.
