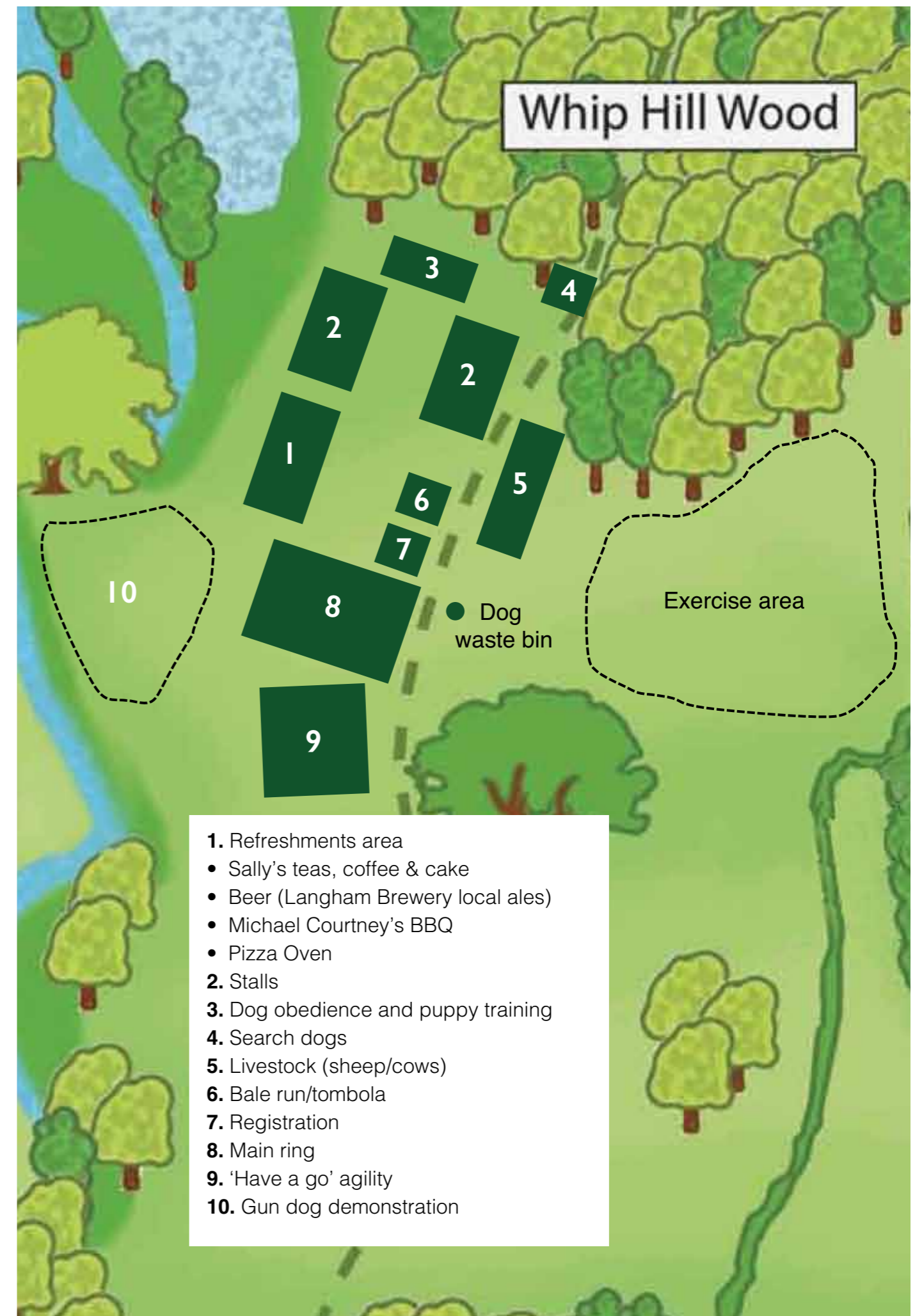

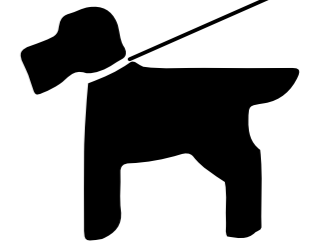

The South Downs National Park is a great place to walk your dog and there's lots of places for responsible dog walkers to explore.

A FEW OF THE BASICS DOS AND DON'TS

- Always keep your dog under close control or on a lead near livestock and in areas where ground-nesting birds may be present
- Never get between a cow and her calf, and if chased let go of your dog
- Don't allow your dog to jump up at other walkers, cyclists or horse-riders
- Always pick up after your dog and place the bag into a waste disposal bin or take it home to dispose of
- For more guidance, pick up the South Downs National Park leaflet 'Guide for dog walkers'
