1. Introduction

- 1.1 At its Annual General Meeting in July 2025 the Authority made its appointments of Members to committees. Since the AGM the Authority, at its meeting in October 2025, appointed Lara Sonola to the Policy and Resources Committee.
- 1.2 Eastbourne District Council have since appointed a new Member to the Authority, Tom Nevill, following the resignation of Peter Diplock. Hampshire County Council have also appointed a new Member to the Authority, Andy Tree, following the resignation of Debbie Curnow-Ford.
- 1.3 Under Schedule 7 Para 13(3) of the Environment Act 1995, the Authority has a duty to secure that the division of local authority appointed Members and Secretary of State appointed Members on any Committee is (as nearly as possible using whole numbers) in the same proportion as required in the case of the Authority itself.

2. Issues for consideration

- 2.1 It is proposed that Tom Nevill be appointed to the Planning Committee and Andy Tree be appointed to the Policy and Resources Committee. These appointment are considered to support the distribution of skills and experience across the Authority's committees (**Appendix 1**) and ensure the Authority is compliant with its duty outlined in paragraph 1.3 of this report.

3. Options and cost implications

- 3.1 The Authority could decide not to make the proposed appointments. However, the proposed appointment supports previous decisions of the Authority and are in line with the Authority's approach that all Members be appointed to a committee of the Authority.
- 3.2 The costs associated with the administration of the decision-making structures of the Authority are met from within the Authority's core budget.

- 4.1 Officers will take the necessary administrative steps to deliver the new committee membership.
