



















CIL in the National Park



- Charges apply to new housing and supermarkets only
- Charges based on each new square metre (net)
- Exclusions include affordable housing, extensions & self-build
- Largely replaces Section 106 agreements
- 25% of income passed directly to Parish Councils with a Neighbourhood Plan
- Solely to fund infrastructure





The Draft CIL Charging Schedule

Use / type	Charge (per m²)	Locations
Residential	£150	Zone I - Petersfield, Lewes, Petworth, Midhurst
	£100	Zone 2 – Liss
	£200	Zone 3 - Everywhere else
Large format retail	£120	Supermarkets, everywhere
All other development	£0	Everywhere

• "Includes" transport schemes, flood defences, schools, community services, sports and leisure facilities, open spaces...








- CIL can be used to fund the provision (capital), improvement, replacement, operation (revenue) or maintenance of infrastructure.
- Projects identified on an Infrastructure Delivery Plan (IDP)
