The Basic Conditions Statement describes how the FNDP meets the four basic conditions with a description on conformity provided for each individual test. Conformity with National Policy set out at Section 3, conformity with the development plan at Section 5 and a description of how the plan contributes to achieving sustainable development at Section 4. Section 6 of the Basic Conditions Statement describes how the FNDP is compatible with EU obligations, again referring to the SEA and HRA which have informed the development of the FNDP. The FNDP has been subject to a full Strategic Environmental Assessment and Habitats Regulation Assessment. Section 4 refers to the Strategic Environmental Assessment incorporating sustainability appraisal which demonstrates the FNDP contribution to sustainable development of the plan in relation to European designations. The SEA and HRA have resulted in a number of modifications to the FNDP to ensure the plan conforms to the basic conditions.

Fittleworth Parish Council was established as the Qualifying Body, responsible for the preparation of the FNDP when the Neighbourhood Area was designated on 5 March 2015. The Fittleworth Parish Council agreed the Submission version of the FNDP at a meeting held on 21 January 2019 The FNDP contains 9 planning policies which are in relation to development and the use of land. Policy Fitt9 provides details of site allocations and includes development briefs for each allocated sites incorporating policy requirements to reflect the findings of SEA and HRA The time period for the FNDP is 15 years 2018 - 2033, as stated on the front cover of the FNDP The FNDP does not include policies on excluded development. The FNDP contains policies which only relate to the Fittleworth Neighbourhood Area.
