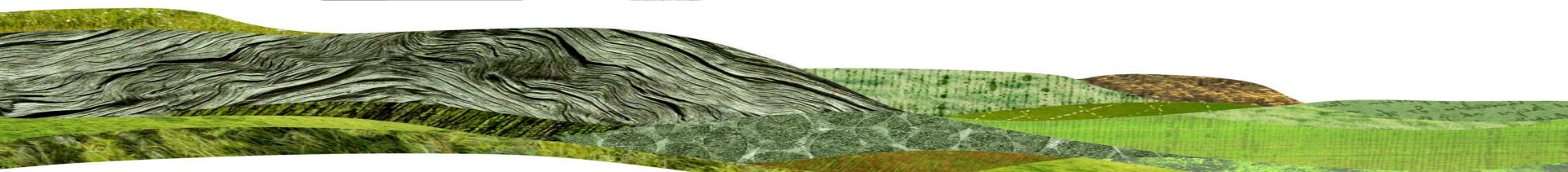

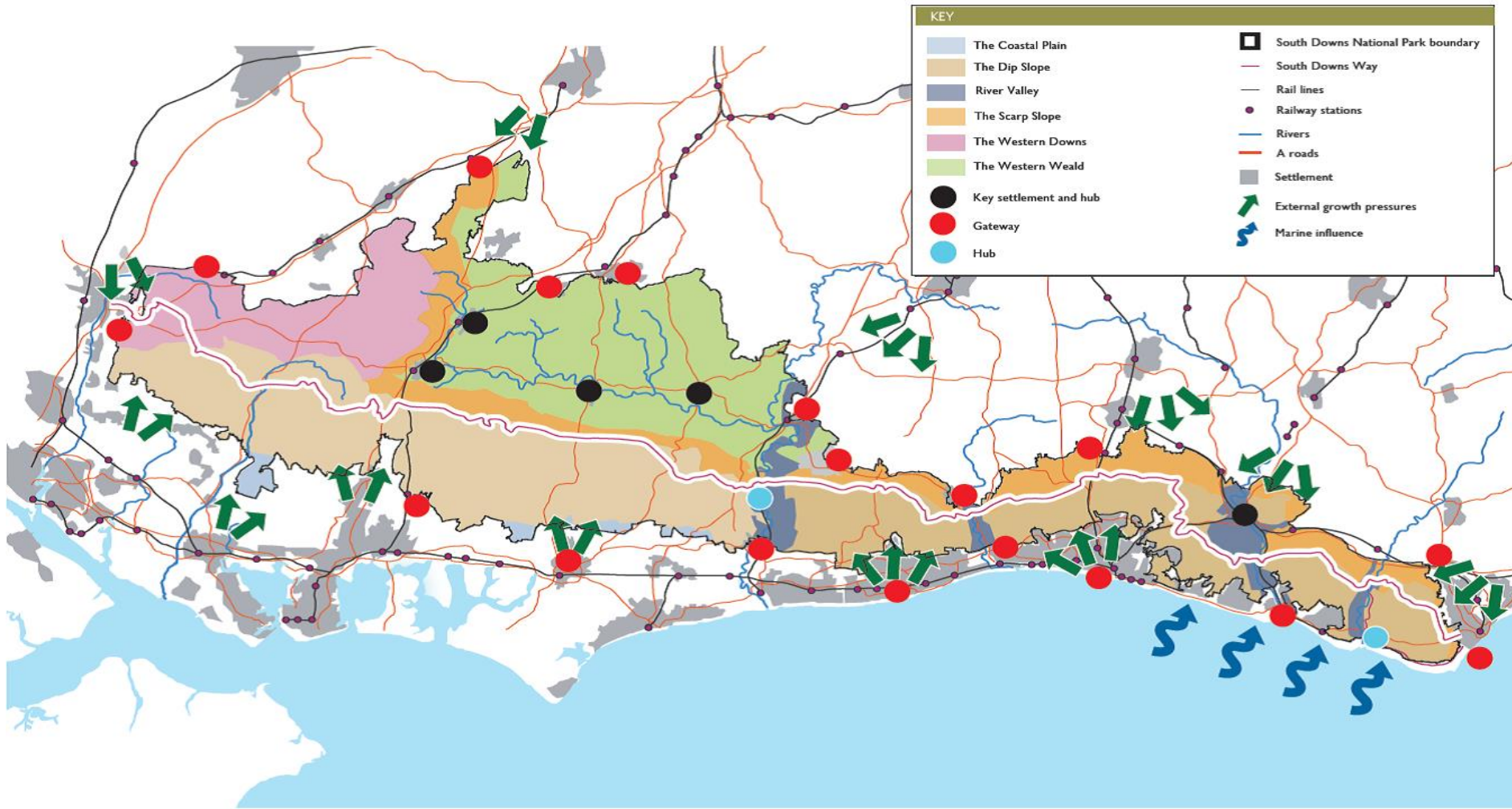

## CONCEPTUAL SPATIAL DIAGRAM

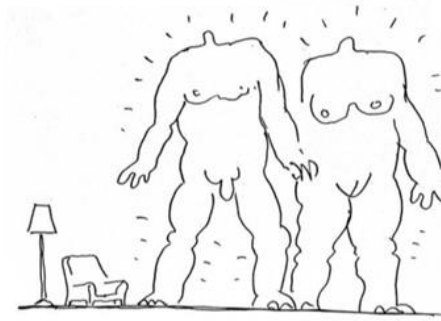
SOUTH DOWNS

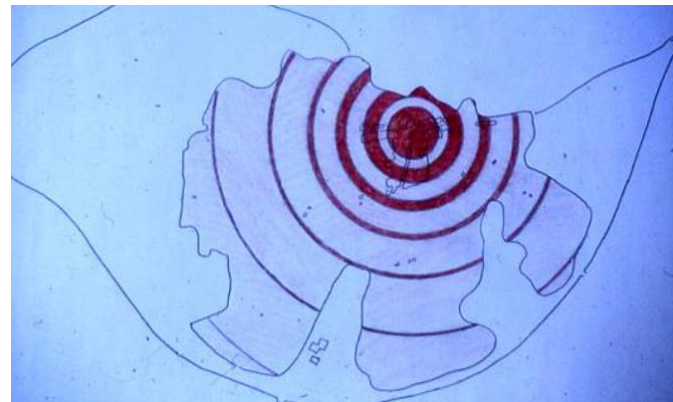

MULTIPLICATION



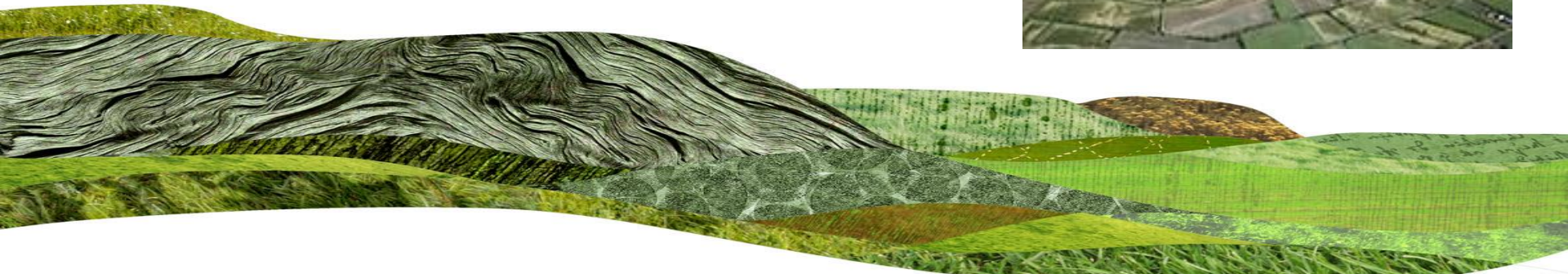
MONSTROUS FORM OF GROWTH  
OBESITY





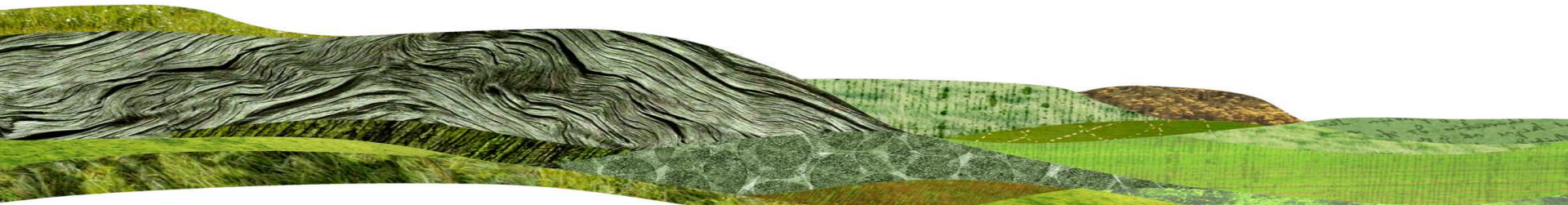
