Suggested alternative text for paragraphs 6.13 - 6.15 and BNDP Policy 8 of Bury Neighbourhood Plan in relation to Parish Heritage Assets

PARISH HERITAGE ASSETS

6.13. It has become clear through consultation exercises that there are other locally important features around within the Parish that are of particular historic value and significance important to people that live and work in the community.

"Village Primary School - I love to live in a village with a school"

- 6.14. The Parish of Bury has a number of important heritage assets and these should which should be protected preserved for the enjoyment of future generations. The relationship between of these assets within and the landscape contributes to the unique nature of the Parish. Some of these heritage assets have been protected under by nNational or local Ddesignations (including conservation area, listed buildings and and scheduled ancient monuments designation). However there are a number of assets which considerably form part of contribute to our sense of heritage that currently do not benefit from any protection for their specific historic significance.
- 6.15. A review of our heritage assets has been carried out and this is documented in the evidence base supporting this plan. This identifies buildings and features which contribute to the history of the Parish and are important to local people and worthy of policy protection.

BNDP Policy 8 - Parish Heritage Assets

Development proposals will be supported where they protect and where possible enhance Parish Heritage Assets as identified on the BNDP MAP.

All proposals that directly impact, or impact on the setting of Parish Heritage Assets, must provide a heritage statement describe the impact of the development on the significance of the heritage asset, demonstrating that the significance of that asset will not be unacceptably affected.
