### **TAKE NOTICE THAT:**

In accordance with Section 173A (1) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) the South Downs National Park Authority hereby varies:

- (a) Requirement 5 (2) (d) of the Enforcement Notice dated 13<sup>th</sup> June 2016 (true copy attached hereto) so as to delete the words "in good forestry practice, as per the 'UK Forestry Standard', to allow replanting as specified in the Restocking Notice" leaving the requirement to be "to grade and level the surface in keeping with the soil type of the site to allow regeneration of replanted trees".
- (b) The time for compliance within paragraph 6 of the Enforcement Notice dated 13 June 2016 as follows:
  - 1. 1 day after the enforcement notice taking effect
  - 2a. 6 months after the enforcement notice taking effect
  - 2b. 6 months after the enforcement notice taking effect
  - 2c. 6 months after the enforcement notice taking effect
  - 2d. 6 months after the enforcement notice taking effect
