

Volunteer – Dog Walking Ambassador

The Heathlands Reunited Team are seeking keen volunteers who are interested in becoming dog walking ambassadors.

As a dog walking ambassador you will form part of a team that will work across the Heathlands Reunited Project Area. You will learn how to positively engage and educate locals about the importance of responsible dog ownership on heathland sites.

Your effort will be part of a park wide behavioural change campaign. Each volunteer will be required to sign up to an ambassador's code of conduct.

Training and equipment will be provided.

Transport: *The ability to transport yourself to your designated site (either through public transport or in your own vehicle) might be an advantage in this role.*

Preferred/ Est. Hours: 1 day a week

Role Description:

- Interacting and engaging with members of the public
- General site walks
- Manning information stalls – pop up gazebos
- Partnership working – communicating with site managers at all times

Key Skills:

- Approachable and friendly a good communicator
- A positive mediator that is empathetic
- A love of dogs and meeting new people

Key qualities: Friendly, Good communicator, Problem solver, Reliable, Inquisitive, Thorough, Enthusiastic

Key Responsibilities:

- Will work with the project team to meet the objectives of the project
- Work professionally and considerately
- Will follow the applicable South Downs National Park Authority Policies e.g. Health and Safety (Risk Assessments) and Best Practice at all times
- Able to deliver tasks on your own initiative within the project format
