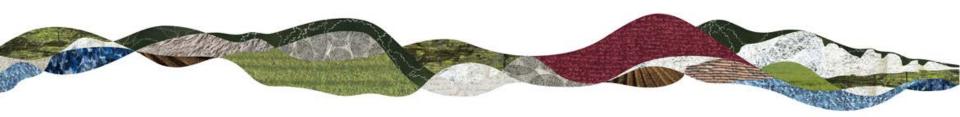

Proposal for 40 space public car park to be constructed on a small agricultural field including provision for cycle stands and partial removal and replanting of hedgerow at Keymer Road Ditchling.

Native trees



Native Tree Planting: Acer campestre

(Field Maple) Quercus robur (English Oak)

Mixed native hedgerow





Native Mixed Hedgerow to include but not be limited to:

- Carpinus betulus (Hornbeam)
- Corylus avellana (Common Hazel)
- Crataegus monogyna (Common Hawthorn)
- Prunus spinosa (Blackthorn)
- Viburnum opulus (Guelder Rose)

Hedgerow to be planted in a double staggered row. Species to be planted in groups of 3,5 and 7.

Native mixed shrub planting





Native Thicket Species to include but not be limited to:

- Cornus sanguinea (Common Dogwood)
- Rosa canina (Dog Rose)
- llex aquifolium (Common Holly)
- Prunus spinosa (Blackthorn)
- Viburnum opulus (Guelder Rose)

Native thicket species to be planted at 1m centres.

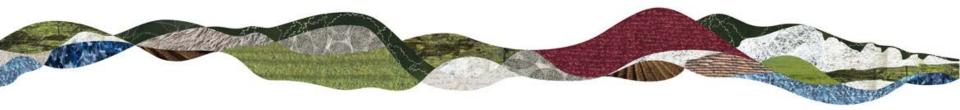

Recommendation

- I. That planning permission be granted subject to:
- i) the conditions set out in Section 10 of this report.
- ii) the completion of a Section 106 agreement to secure highways improvements including a financial contribution for the amendment of an existing Traffic Regulation Order (TRO)
- Amendments to conditions 3, 6 and 7 in accordance with the updates sheet
- 2. That authority be delegated to the Director of Planning to refuse the application, with appropriate reasons if the \$106 is not completed or sufficient progress has not been made within 3 months of the 14 September Planning Committee meeting
