## **Recommendation:**

The Authority is recommended to appoint Roger Huxstep to the SDNPA Planning Committee with effect from 19 December 2017.

## I. Summary and Background

- 1.1 Responsibility for appointing members to Committee sits with the NPA. Standing orders require that should a vacancy arise on a committee the Authority should act to fill the vacancy as soon as is practicable.
- 1.2 Following the resignation of Authority Member Amber Thacker in November a vacancy has arisen on the Planning Committee.
- 1.3 It is proposed that Roger Huxstep, the new Winchester City Council Member of the Authority, be appointed to fill this vacancy on Planning Committee with immediate effect.
