The following topics have already been put forward as issues for the LAF to consider. The following proposal is a broad outline of potential projects and site visits for the year ahead. Each meeting will focus on one primary issue. If there are particularly complex or long running projects the LAF might like to convene a smaller working group to take forward particular projects.

The issues and timetable below is the current starting point, however if pressing issues arise they will be added into the work program and existing items will be deferred or drops as appropriate with the agreement of the LAF.

January 23rd 2018

Potential diversion of Bridleway Bramber 3183, Annington Hill, West Sussex. Site visit to Annington Hill.

April 17th 2018 (AGM)

Potential all day SDLAF with meeting in the morning and site visit in the afternoon. Potential new route for the SDW between Cheesefoot Head and Winchester City. Site visit to point along the current and proposed route. (Potential combined site visit with SDW Trail partnership subject to agreement.)

July 17th 2018

Workshop to consider how future agri-environment schemes could support public access. Possible site visit to see case study to see permissive farm access in action.

October 23rd 2018

Ongoing flooding issues at Stocks Lane on the Meon Valley Trail. Site visit to review options.

Other potential projects / issues

Review of Open Access site stiles (Prioritisation of stiles to gates)
Review of 'Access for All' / 'Access for Many' routes and prioritisation of project work.
