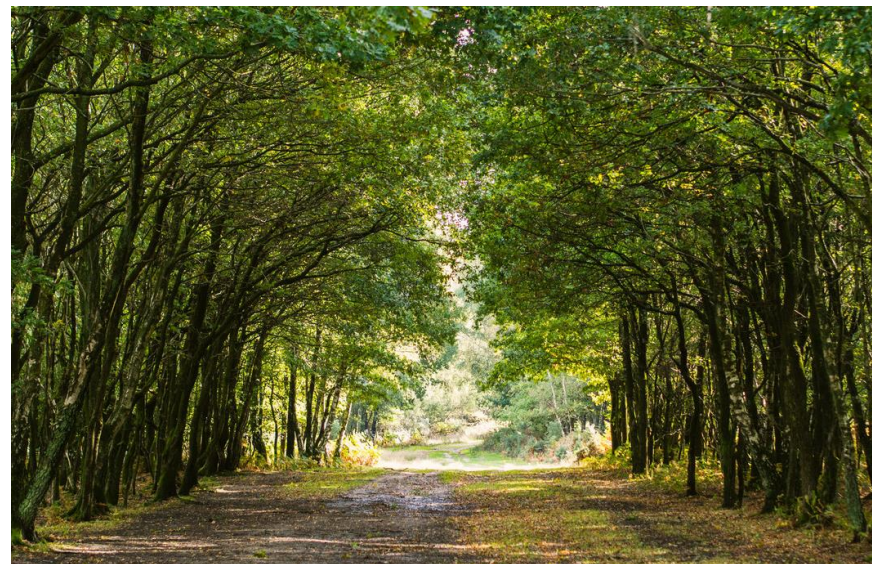
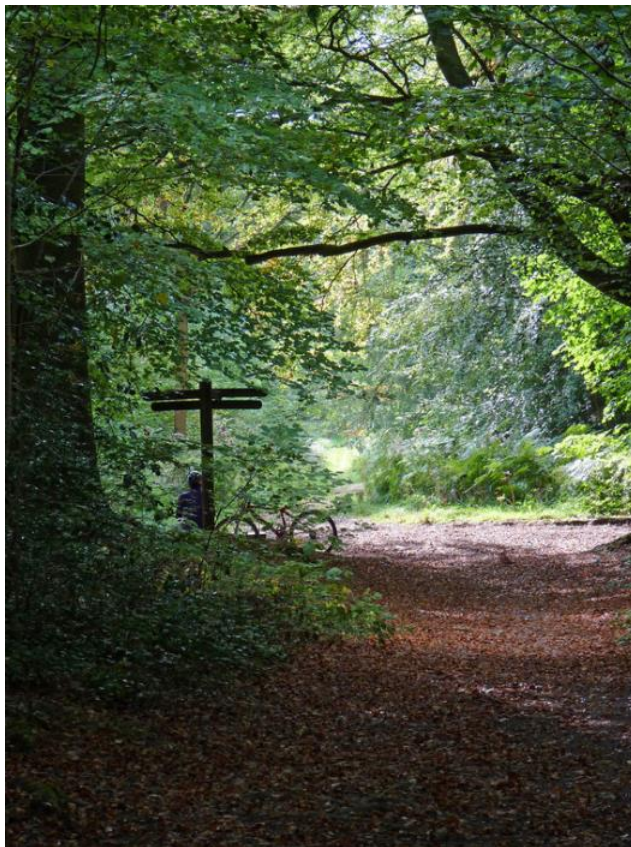

**8,000** businesses in the National Park

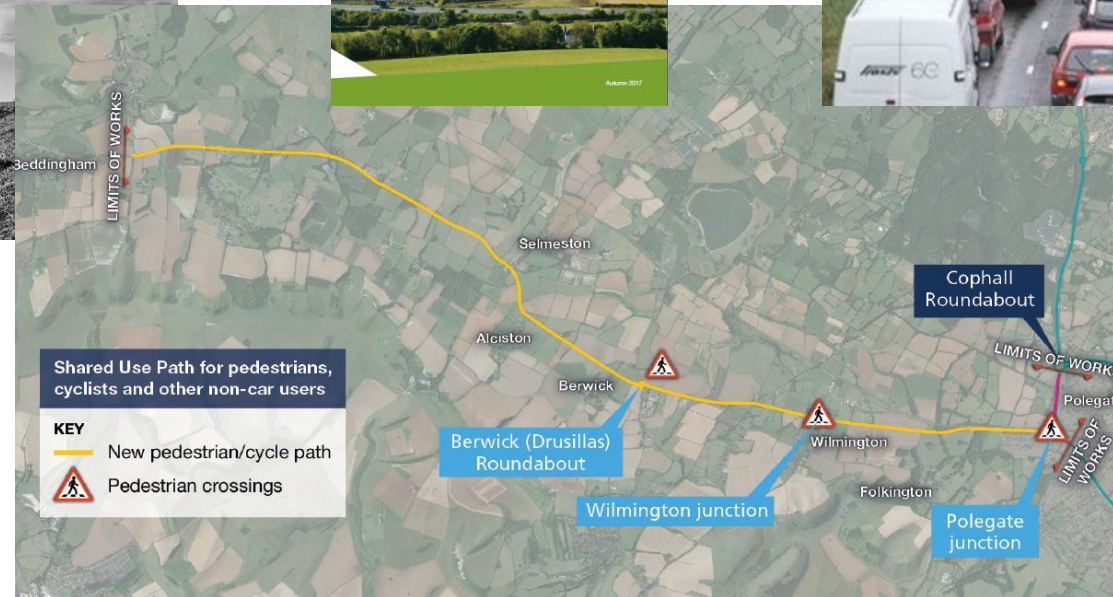

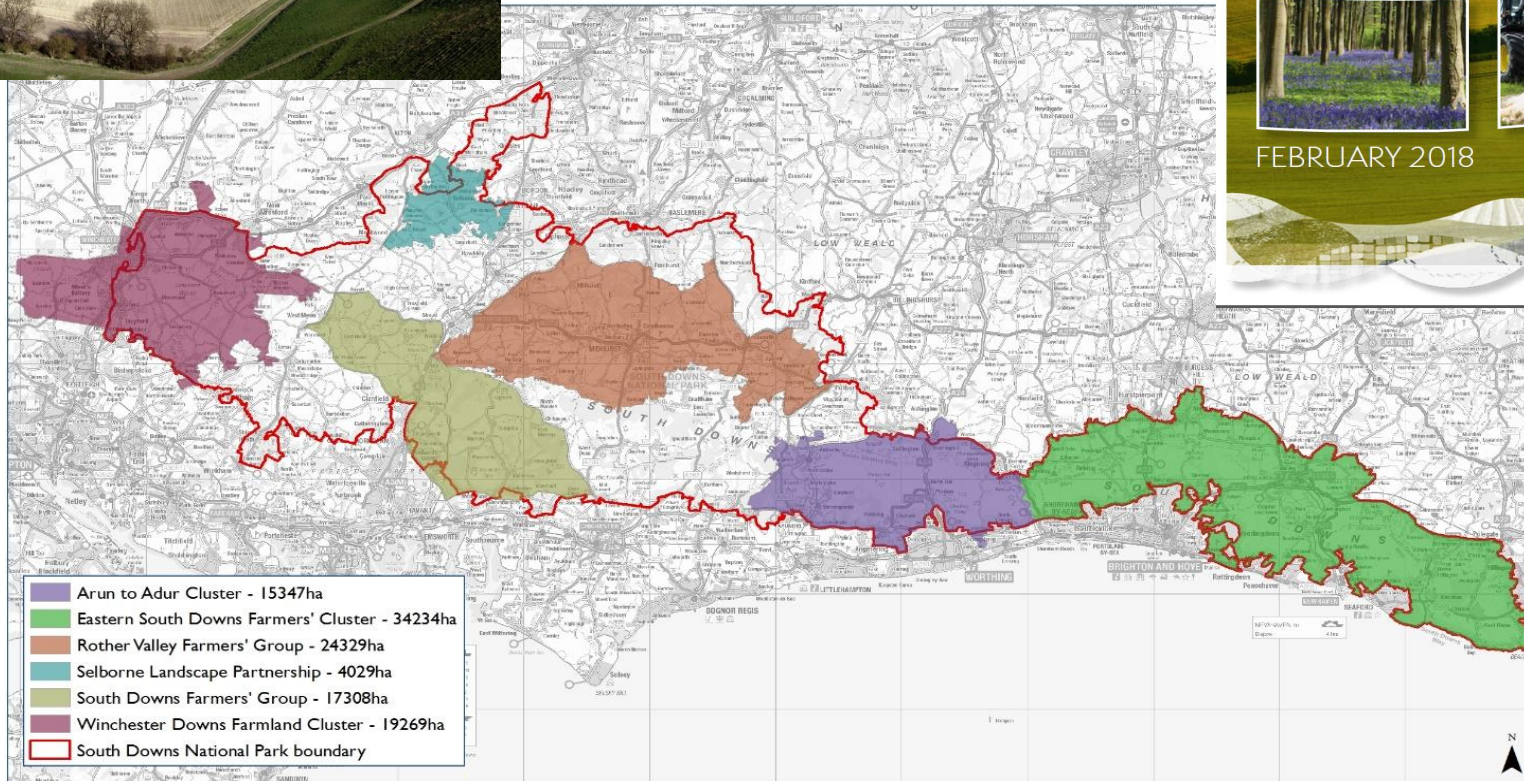
