



Adoption of the Joint Wealden Heaths Phase II Special Protection Area Supplementary Planning Document

Statement of Adoption

12th July 2018

In accordance with Regulation 11 and 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that South Downs National Park Authority adopted the Joint Wealden Heaths Phase II Special Protection Area Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 12 July 2018. This SPD was prepared to support the implementation of Policies CP14, CP15 and CP22 of the East Hampshire and South Downs National Park Authority Joint Core Strategy.

The adopted Joint Wealden Heaths Phase II Special Protection Area SPD relates to the whole of East Hampshire District including those parts within the South Downs National Park. East Hampshire District Council will adopt the SPD separately.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
