Bigger. Better. Joined up

Heathland covers just one per cent of the South Downs National Park, mostly separated into 'islands' where isolated plants and animals are far more vulnerable to local extinction. Heathland is rarer than rainforest and home to all 12 of our native reptiles and amphibians.

The Heathlands Reunited project, is a partnership of 11 like-minded organisations, led by the South Downs National Park Authority. The project runs for 5 years from 2016-2021 with an area covering 41 heathland sites.

Our aim is to recreate, reconnect, and restore existing heathland to cover an area greater than 1,200 football pitches.

The project also aims to re-engage and inspire communities to visit their heathlands, learn more about them and work together to look after them so they can be enjoyed for generations to come.

ACCESSIBILITY: Paths at Chapel Common can be rough so is unsuitable for pushchairs.

FACILITIES: No toilets. From Liss; take the B2070 towards Liphook, then the second hand turn after Rake CE Primary School. Limited parking is available on this road.

DESCRIPTION OF WALK: Walk from Chapel through Forest mere to Weavers Down. Then walking back to Chapel Common.

ACCESSIBILITY: Occasionally difficult terrain- unsuitable for wheelchairs and push chairs. Likely to be wet and muddy.

FACILITIES: Free car park whilst space allows.

DESCRIPTION OF WALK: Join the HCC Ranger service for a guided walk around Shortheath Common before heading out across the countryside to Broxhead Common. Take a circular walk around Broxhead before returning to the Shortheath carpark.

FACILITIES: Car park available. No toilets. From Midhurst; take exit on roundabout to A272 Petersfield Road, follow for about 2 miles and turn off onto Elsted Road, the car park is on the right.

DESCRIPTION OF WALK: A longer health walk through the beautiful heathlands at Iping Common. Please arrive 10 minutes early.
