Many farmers have out-of-date or unwanted chemicals in store, which can be costly or awkward to dispose of. To avoid them getting into our water supply, we want to help you remove them safely.

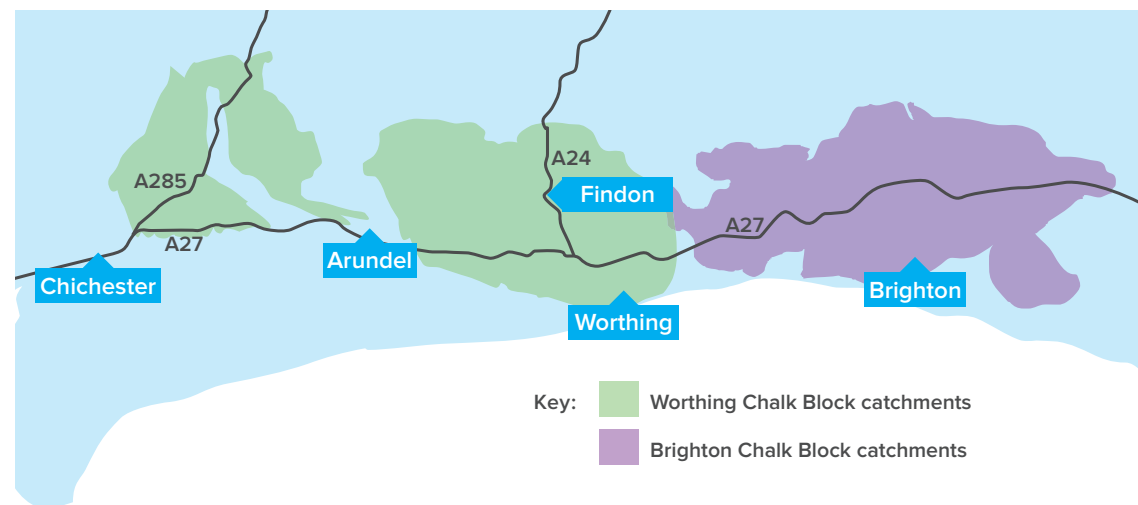
We're offering free collections for up to 75 litres. To arrange this, we've teamed up with Chem Clear – a specialist chemical waste collection and disposal company.

Terms and conditions:

To qualify, part of your farm must be located within an eligible catchment. This offer is time and budget limited and farms will be prioritised on a first-come, first-served basis. The scheme is confidential in as much as the chemical type and quantity will not be linked to a given farm when the data is provided to Southern Water.

Booking a collection is simple:

- Step 1:** Check your farm is eligible using the map opposite or by contacting Chem Clear.
- Step 2:** Contact Chem Clear by 30 November 2019 to arrange a collection.
- Step 3:** Your unwanted pesticides will be collected in December 2019.

If you want to dispose of more than 75 litres, you can arrange this with Chem Clear. We will cover the cost of the first 75 litres and any additional chemicals to dispose of will be a private arrangement between your farm and Chem Clear.
