It lists the conditions as proposed by the Applicant, (they are required to submit a list of proposed conditions as part of the ROMP process) and then leads onto the revised conditions as suggested by the Case Officer, (who has reviewed the proposed conditions and subsequently provided amended conditions that accord with statutory consultee responses), that are titled 'Recommended Conditions'. For the sake of clarity the 'Recommended Conditions' are the final conditions that form section 10.1 of the report that Members are being recommended to approve.</p>
