

I. Sustainable Communities Fund 2019-2020 Grant Allocations

I.IWildlife on our Doorstep Education Programme – Tuppeny Barn, Southbourne, West
Sussex - £1,500 grant towards the total project cost of £3,698

The education programme gives children living in and around the South Downs National Park the opportunity to learn about ecosystems, sustainability and biodiversity.

1.2 Wildflower Conservation Society – Brighton - £1,500 towards a total cost of £12,523

To erect a polytunnel on the site at Stanmer Park for wildflower propagation enabling John Gapper to impart his unique and invaluable knowledge to the volunteers of the Wildflower Conservation Society

1.3 <u>Petworth Heritage Open Days – Petworth, West Sussex - £750 towards a total project cost</u> of £7,500

For several Petworth based heritage sites to work collaboratively on Saturday 21st and Sunday 22^{nd} September 2019 to encourage both local and wider public engagement in exploring our local heritage

1.4 Lavant Lives – Lavant, West Sussex - £5,000 towards a total project cost of £13,702

To install 4 interpretation boards in Lavant. Renovate a K6 telephone box and create a heritage document. This is a collaborative venture developing and establishing partnerships within the village.

1.5 <u>Expansion of seating capacity – Fernhurst Community Shop, West Sussex - £2,000 towards a</u> total project cost of £7,000

Purchase of a made to measure marquee/awning to attach to our existing community café to significantly extend our seating capacity during the winter months.

I.6Eco-cabin - Moulsecombe Forest Garden and Wildlife Project - Moulsecombe, Brighton -
£1,998 towards a total project cost of £4,198

Making our Eco-cabin earn its keep – clean, sand and varnish wooden floors; put in lightin and heating to run off the solar panels which they already have; outdoor lighting for evening events; rustic freestanding bookcase, display cabinet and shelving; fix balcony walls and wattle and daub walls – all to enable to facility to be rented out and usable year round thereby enhancing a revenue stream for the project.

1.7 Hampshire Monday Group – Hampshire - £2,000 towards a total project cost of £4,500

Start-up funds are required for the volunteer group to purchase power tools and insurance to improve the Ashford Hangers Nature Reserve and to improve public access to the countryside along Rights of Way.
