BREACH OF CONDITION NOTICE

TO: 

1. THIS NOTICE is served issued by the Council, under Section 187A of the above Act, because they consider that a condition imposed on a grant of planning permission, relating to the land described in paragraph 2 below, has not been complied with. The Council consider that you should be required to comply with the conditions specified in this notice. The Annex at the end of this notice contains important additional information.

2. THE LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land at Osiers Farm, London Road, Petworth, West Sussex shown edged red on the attached plan.

3. THE RELEVANT PLANNING PERMISSION

The relevant planning permission to which this notice relates is the permission granted by the Council on 27th April 2017 for Change of use of existing golf club car park to lorry park (sui genesis), ref. SDNP/16/04284/FUL.

4. THE BREACH OF CONDITION

The following condition has not been complied with:-

Condition 3

3. Maximum number of HGV's/trailers

No more than six HGV's or trailers (or combination thereof) shall be parked on the application site at any one time unless agreed by way of an application to the SDNPA on that behalf.

Reason: To ensure that the use does not have an adverse impact on the character or appearance of the National Park or on highway safety.

The Council considers that this condition has not been complied with because the Land is being used for the parking of more than six HGV's or trailers or combinations thereof.

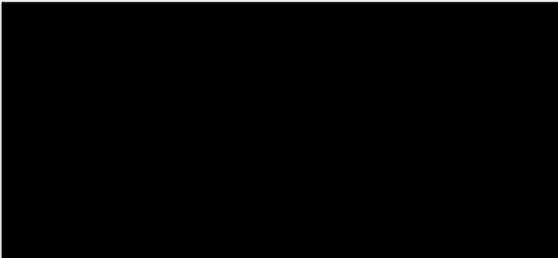
5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

As the person responsible for the breach of condition specified in paragraph 4 of this notice, you are required to comply with the stated condition by taking the following steps:-

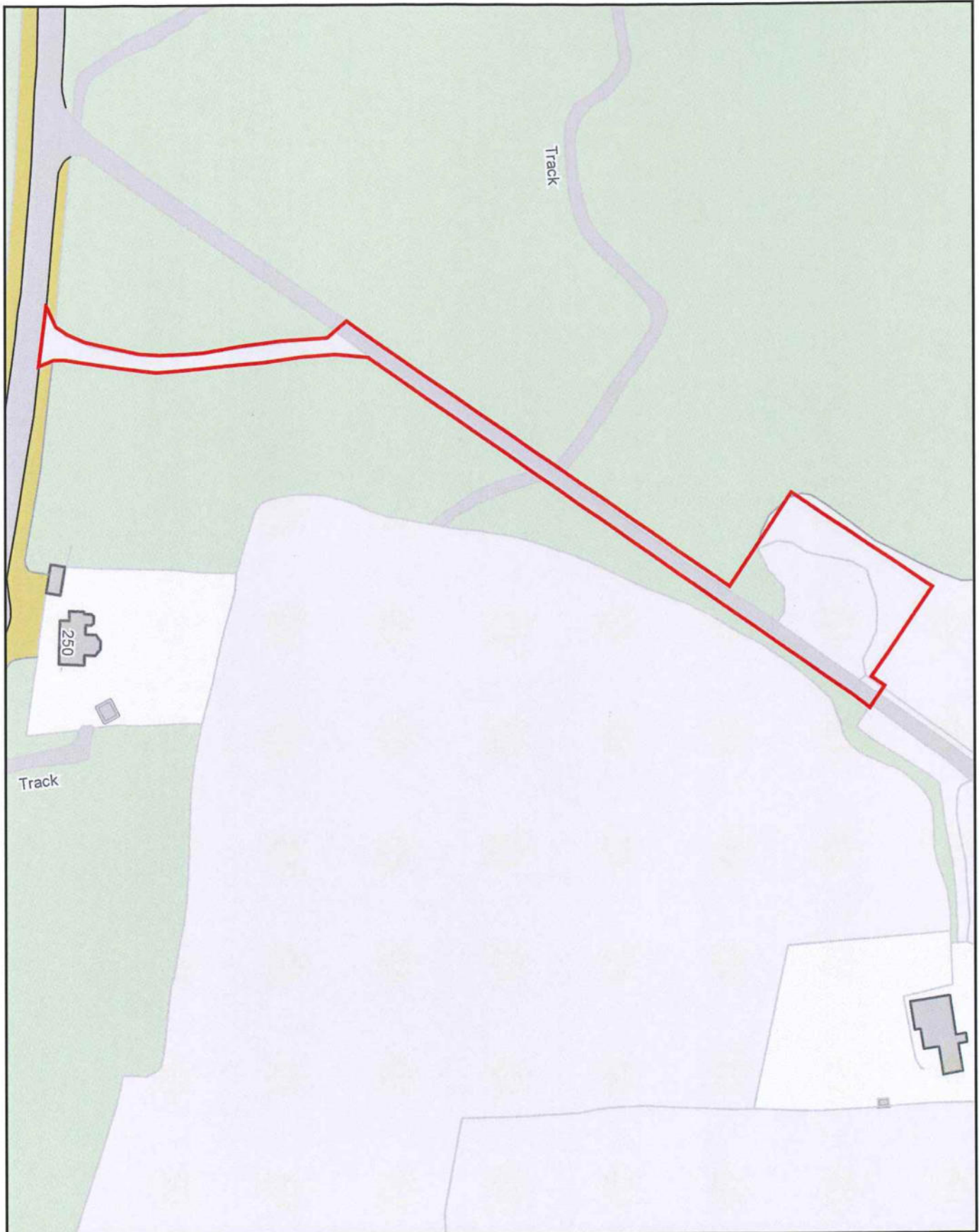
Reduce the number of HGVs or trailers (or combination thereof) parked on the Land at any one time to no more than six.

Period for compliance: One month beginning with the date that this notice is served on you.

You will then be at risk of immediate prosecution in the Magistrates' Court, for which the maximum penalty is £1,000 for a first offence and for any subsequent offence.
