There is no form of public transport up to Truleigh Hill. You can drive to the Beeding Hill car park or the YHA. Please lift share where possible because there is limited parking in these two areas. The SDNPA are looking into working with a local bus shuttle company to help those who cannot access the area and provide an occasional service from Shoreham and back.
