Notice is hereby given that the accounts of South Downs National Park Authority, in respect of the financial year ended 31 March 2023, will be available for public inspection as set out below:

1. Sections 26 and 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014 provide for:

- Any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the Annual Return and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts etc. relating to them. For the year ended 31 March 2023, these documents will be available on reasonable notice on application to the person in paragraph 2 below.

Local Government Electors, their representatives and other interested parties have rights to:

- question the auditor about the accounts; and
- object to the accounts for any item in them. Written notice of an objection must first be given to the Auditor and a copy sent to the Authority.
