Declaration

- c) in the circumstances of (b) above, fail to give notice to the Authority’s Monitoring Officer of the interest within 28 days of the meeting (unless the unregistered interest is the subject of a pending notification); or
- d) participate in any discussion or vote on the matter in which I have a disclosable pecuniary interest (unless I have received a dispensation in accordance with the Localism Act 2011).

Furthermore, I recognise that it is a breach of the Localism Act 2011 and a criminal offence, to provide information that is false or misleading and I:-

- a) know that the information is false or misleading; or
- b) am reckless as to whether the information is true and not misleading.
