TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4 RELATING TO LAND IN THE

PARISH OF FITTLEWORTH

WHEREAS the Council of the District of Chichester of Greyfriars North Street Chichester West Sussex being the Local Planning Authority for the said District are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land situate in the Parish of Fittleworth in the County of West Sussex shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto (being development comprised within paragraph 1 of Class II (Sundry Minor Operations) of the First Schedule to the said Order)

SCHEDULE

The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding 1 metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or 2 metres in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure: so long as such improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate for a new means of enclosure _____


