NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the description set out in the Schedule hereto

SCHEDULE

The use of land for the purpose of motor-cycle racing (including practising) for not more than 14 days in total in any calendar year and the erection or placing of moveable structures on the land for the purposes of that use being development included in paragraph 2 of Class IV referred to in Schedule 1 to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other paragraph or Class.
