COUNCIL DISTRICT TOWN AND COUNTRY/GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 1973 TO 1976 WHEREAS The District Council of Lewes (hereinafter called "the District Council") are entitled under the powers delegated to them by the County Council for the Administrative County of East Sussex (hereinafter called "the County Council") to exercise the powers and duticity The commission of the town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973, as amended. AND WHEREAS It appears to the District Council acting on behalf of the County Council to be expedient that development of the descriptions set out in Schedule l hereto should not be carried out on the land at Harbour Heights, Peacehaven, Sussex set out in Schedule 2 hereto and shown edged in red on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefore is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973, M amakoled, NOW THEREFORE The said District Council in pursuance of the powers Conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning
General Divelopment Order, 1973 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission
Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto. THIS Direction may be cited as the Lewes District Council (Peacehaven) Direction, 1976. SCHEDULE 1 Development comprised within Class II and Class VI referred to in the First Schedule to the said Order and not being development comprised within any other Class, and respectively set cut in the following paragraphs :-CLASS II : Sundry Minor Operations 1. The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding 1 metre in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or 2 metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure: so long as such improvement or alteration does not increase the height above the height appropriate for a new means of enclosure. 2. The formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to a highway not being a trunk or classified road, where required in connection with development permitted by Article 3 of and Schedule 1 to this Order (other than under this Class). The painting of the exterior of any building or work otherwise announcement or direction. than for the purpose of advertisement, CLASS VI : Agricultural buildings, works and uses 1. The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture (other than the placing on land of structure not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings), so long as: (a) the ground area covered by a building erected pursuant to this permission does not, either by itself or after the addition thereto of the ground area covered by any existing

building or buildings (other than a dwellinghouse) within the same unit erected or in course of erection within the preceding two years and wholly or partly within 90 metres of the nearest

part of the said building, exceed 465 square metres

- (b) the height of any buildings or works does not exceed 3 metres in the case of a building or works within 3 kilometres of the perimeter of an aerodrome, nor 12 metres in any other case
- (c) no part of any buildings (other than moveable structures) or works is within 25 metres of the metalled portion of a trunk or classified road.
- 2. The winning and working, on land held or occupied with land used for the purposes of agriculture, of any minerals reasonably required for the purposes of that use, including:-

(i) the fertilisation of the land so used, and

(ii) the maintenance, improvement or alteration of buildings or works thereon which are occupied or used for the purposes aforesaid

so long as no excavation is made within 25 metres of the metalled portion of a trunk or classified road.


