COUNTY OF EAST SUSSEX

Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950.

WHEREAS the County Planning Committee of the County Council of East Sussex, acting on behalf of the County Council as the Local Planning Authority for the said County, are satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule unless permission therefor is granted upon an application duly made in that behalf:

NOW THEREFORE the said Committee in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950 HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in Part I of the Schedule hereto in any part of the land described in Part II of the said Schedule.

This Direction may be cited as the East Sussex (Ditchling) Direction, 1959.

The Schedule above referred to

Part I

The carrying out on the land described in Part II hereof of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, market gardens and nursery grounds, being development comprised within Class V of the first Schedule to the said Order and not within any other class.

Part II

All that piece or parcel of land situate in the parish of Ditchling on the south side of the Ditchling - Hurstpierpoint Road B.2116 comprising ordnance Parcel Number 429 on the 1/2500 Ordnance Survey Sussex (East) Sheet LIII.2. Edition of 1910 and more particularly delineated in the plan attached hereto and thereon coloured pink.

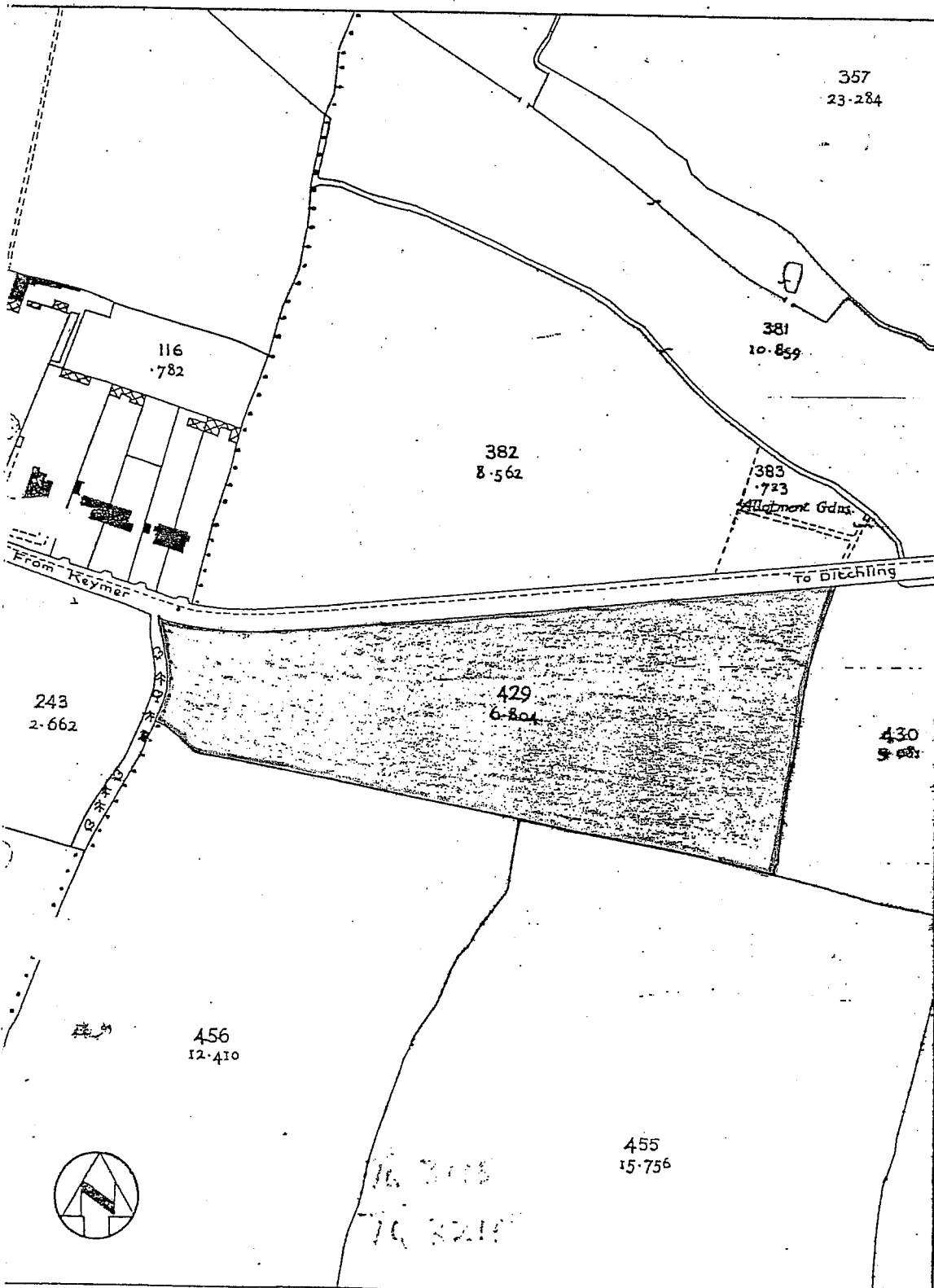
