Town and Country Planning (General Development) Order, 1950

Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order, 1960

DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4, NO.13

W H E R E A S:

(1) Article 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1950 as amended by the Town and Country Planning General Development (Amendment) Order, 1960 (hereinafter called "the Order") permits the following development:-

1. The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings.

~~2. The erection or construction and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of roadside stands for milk churns, except where they would abut on any trunk or classified road.~~

3. The winning and working, on land held or occupied with land used for the purposes of agriculture, of any minerals reasonably required for the purposes of that use including the fertilisation of the land so used and the maintenance improvement or alteration of buildings or works thereon which are occupied or used for the purposes aforesaid ~~being Class VI of the First Schedule to the Order~~

(2) The operations specified in the First Schedule hereto constitute development within Class VI⁽¹⁾ of the Order

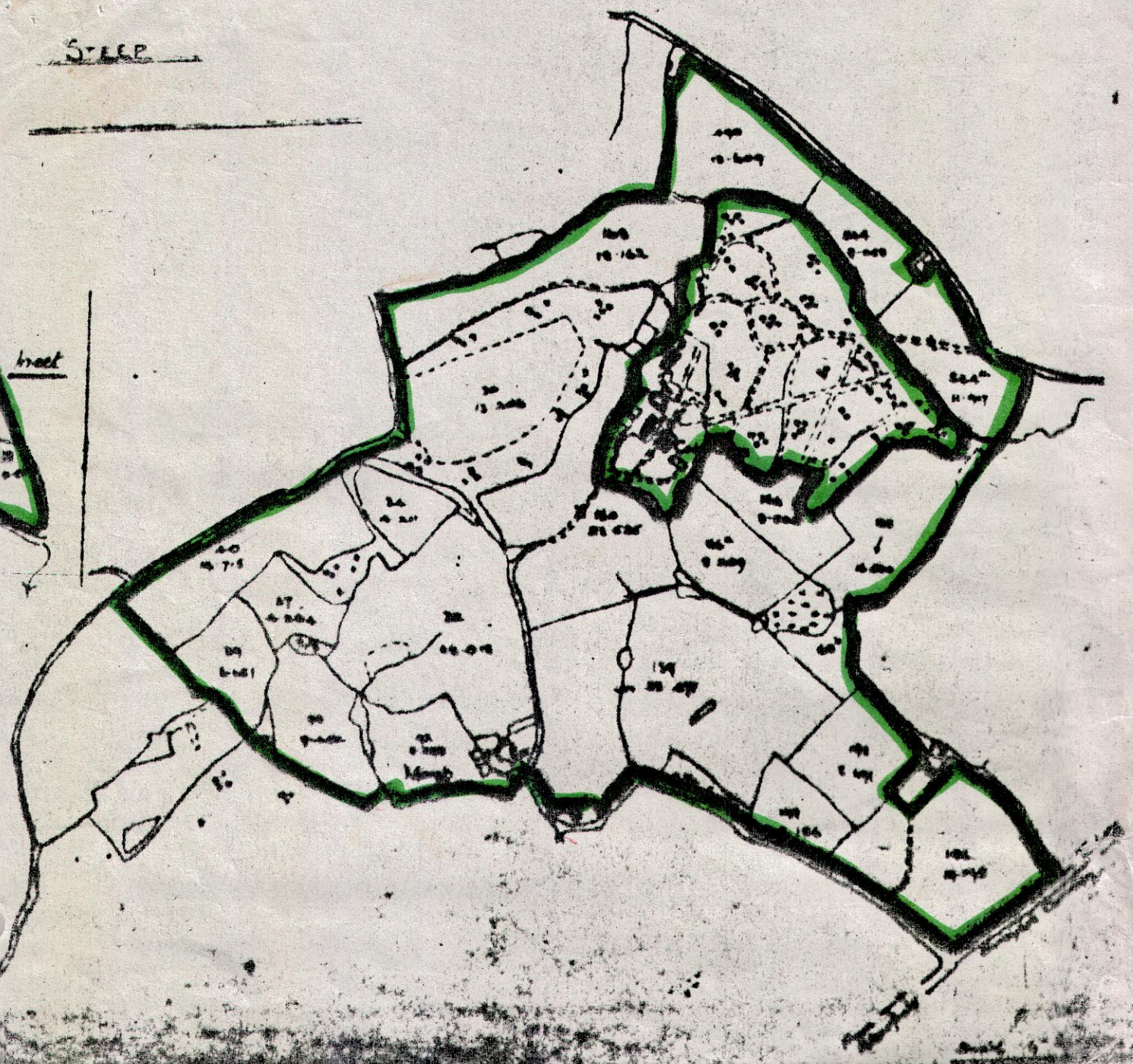
(3) The Hampshire County Council (hereinafter called "the Council") are the Local Planning Authority for the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto.

(4) The Council is satisfied that it is expedient that the development specified in the First Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Order

N O W T H E R E F O R E The Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1950, HEREBY DIRECT that the permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to the development specified in the First Schedule hereto in respect of the land specified in the Second Schedule hereto

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture, other than the placing on land of structures not designed for those purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings.
