IN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDER 1977

WHEREAS WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL of City Offices Colebrook Street Winchester Hampshire being the local planning authority for the area in which the land referred to in the First Schedule hereto (hereinafter called the land) is situated are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1977 hereby direct that the permission granted by article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the land of the description set out in the Second Schedule hereto

THE FIRST SCHEDULE (The Land)

All those pieces and parcels of land along the valley of the River Itchen from near the source of the said River at a point north of Cheriton to a point north of Shewford all in the County of Hampshire more particularly shown coloured green on the attached plan

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

The carrying out on agricultural land having an area of more than one acre and comprised in an agricultural unit of building or engineering operations requisite for the use of that land for the purposes of agriculture (other than the placing on land of structures not designed for the purposes or the provision and alteration of dwellings) being development comprised within Class VI referred to in Schedule I of the said Order and not being development

comprised in any other class for an agricultural for feet.
